As you may already be aware, since September 2021, the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) aspects of our PSHE curriculum are statutory. We use a scheme of work called Kapow for all our RSE resources. An overview of our scheme of work is available on our school website which outlines the key learning objectives that are covered in our RSE curriculum and the progression of skills from Year 1- 6. Each year group will be taught at an appropriate level for their age and developmental stage, building on the previous years' learning. There are some elements of the RSE lessons which parents have the right to withdraw their child from. This can be arranged by contacting Claire Bennett.
