

### P.S.H.E. & C.

In P.S.H.E. & C. this term, we will be focusing on two main topics: Health and Wellbeing and Citizenship. We will learn about how we can look after our bodies with a particular focus on dental hygiene. We will also be talking about our emotions and happiness. Finally, we will learn about human rights.

### Computing

In computing, the children will be learning to email using Microsoft Office 365. They will be able to log in and out of a secure account to compose emails and add an attachment. They will also participate in a session focusing on cyber bullying.

### D.T.

In D.T., the children will work independently to produce an accurate, functioning car. They will design and construct a car body before conducting an accurate trial.

### Art

This term in art, children will be producing a painting that shows an understanding of how colour can be used to show light and dark, and therefore show three dimensions. They will try different arrangements of objects for a composition, explaining their decisions. Children will mix tints and shades by adding black or white paint enabling them to describe the difference between the two.

### R.E.

In R.E. this term, the children will be investigating key aspects of Hindu beliefs and worship. They will examine what it means to be Hindu in Britain today.

After half term, the children will be studying the Easter story and asking why Christians call the day that Jesus died *Good Friday*?
