Rivers and Ancient Egypt

Maths

In **maths**, we will be learning about statistics and interpreting and drawing pictograms and bar charts. We will be recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes and comparing angles. We will be learning how to tell the time using digital and analogue clocks and completing time problems. We will also revisit fractions. Finally, we will be counting money up to £10.00 and finding change.

History

Our **history** topic is Ancient Egypt. This term, we will be learning about who the Ancient Egyptians were and what they believed in. We will also learn about how historians found out about the Egyptians.

Literacy/GPS

In **literacy** this term, we will be studying two texts. Our first text is a fictional story called 'Journey' by Aaron Becker. We will read the text in detail and build up our knowledge of the story by writing our own version.

In the second half of the term, we will be studying the story 'Zeraffa Giraffa' by Diane Hoffmeyer. As the story is a persuasion text, we will work towards planning and writing a persuasive guide for visiting the giraffe in Paris.

French

In **French**, we will be learning the months of the year. We will discuss our birthdays and the birthdays of our family members. In the second half of the term, we will learn about zoo animals. We will name them and share our opinions about animals.

Geography

In **geography** this term, we will be studying rivers. We will be learning about the water cycle, mapping major rivers and learning about their features.

Music

In **music**, we will be listening to a range of rag and tal music, identifying the different Indian instruments used as well as creating improvisations. We will perform these to the class.
