

## Key learning:

- Welcoming our new friends to Nursery and remembering/learning our expectations e.g. 'kind hands' and 'kind words', 'choose it, use it, put it back and wash your hands', 'your turn, my turn', 'walking feet inside, running feet outside', 'quiet voice inside, loud voice outside' etc.
- Exploring the Nursery garden as the season changes from spring to summer and maintaining our Nursery garden as well as planting sunflowers to take home
- Orally blending and segmenting the sounds in words (N2 children – moving up to Reception this September) e.g. 'c-a-t, cat'
- Listening to and joining in with retellings of traditional tales both indoors and outside e.g. 'The Gingerbread man', 'The Three Little Pigs', 'Goldilocks and The Three Bears', 'The Three Billy Goat's Gruff'
- Counting forwards and backwards within 10, including through songs, rhymes and stories, making sets of items to five and combining sets of items to find the total
- Subitising up to four e.g. noticing two, three and four objects without having to count them individually.

## Key vocabulary:

Summer, traditional tales, sunflower, "Just right", "Who's that trip-trapping over my bridge?", "Run, run as fast as you can, you can't catch me, I'm the Gingerbread man!", big, medium-sized, small/little.

## Stories and books

- Non-fiction books about summer, sunflowers and those that appeal to the children's interests and fascinations.
