

Y3 Spring Term

P.E

In P.E. this term, the children will be practising their forehand, backhand, catching and rallying skills through the game of tennis. In dodgeball, they will continue to develop their skills of throwing, catching, dodging, and jumping. In the second half term, the children will develop their balancing, jumping, and rolling skills in gym and within dance. They will create actions in response to a stimulus and move in unison with a partner.

History

In history, the children will be investigating why the Romans settled in Britain and how the Britons responded to the Roman invasion. We will be looking at why their army was so successful and what Roman artefacts tell us about Roman life. We will also be investigating how the Romans changed modern Britain.

P.S.H.E

In P.S.H.E. this term, the children will be looking at health and wellbeing. The children will create a healthy diary. They will also understand the benefits of healthy eating and dental health. In the second half of the term, the children will look at safety and the changing body where they will develop an understanding of unkind online behaviour. They will also find out how to deal with emergency situations.

D.T

In D.T. this term, the children will be creating wearable technology. Looking at digital charms, they will write a programme that initiates a flashing LED panel. They will illustrate how their product is worn and then they will design their product.

Computing

In computing this term, the children will create a storyboard for a book and learn to create digital media for the book as part of a group, and individually on their ipads. The children will also be learning about how to keep themselves safe when online.

R.E

In R.E. this term, the children will be exploring Islamic festivals and how Muslims worship. In the second half term, they will be learning how Jewish festivals and traditions show what matters to Jewish people.

Art

In art this term, the children will be focussing on sculpture and creating abstract shapes. They will combine shapes in different ways and choose appropriate joining methods to create their sculpture.
