Autumn Term

Stone Age to Iron Age

Maths

This term, we will be focusing on place value in 2 and 3 digit numbers. We will be exploring efficient mental strategies for calculating and practising the skills needed for column addition and subtraction. Throughout the term, we will be revising our 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables and corresponding division facts and developing our recall and speed of our 3 and 4 multiplication tables.

History

During this term, the children will be learning about prehistoric history. They will use archaeological evidence to learn about historic houses. They will also explore the limitations of this evidence and the importance of trade during this era.

Literacy/GPS

During the autumn term, the children will be studying the story 'Seal Surfer' by Michael Foreman. The children will be writing a letter from the main character to his grandfather, telling him about the events he has missed. In the second half of the term, we will be looking at the story 'Winter's Child'. They will be writing a fantasy story based on a fable.

French

In French this term, we will be using **Language Nut** to learn about greetings and introductions, colours, days of the week and counting up to 20.

Geography

Children will learn to recognise the physical and human features of their local area and how it has changed. They will then compare their local area with New Delhi and compare land use in two different locations.

Music

In music this term, the children will be exploring ballads. They will create their own ballad and perform their creation at the end of the term.
