

Year 3 Remote Learning Activities

English

Choose from the following activities:

1. Snow Day Journaling

Write a diary entry about your snow day. It can be real or imagined. Describe all the things you can see, hear and feel. Write about an adventure you would like to have in the snow!

Remember to use lots of detail and expanded noun phrases to describe your day.

2. Snow Day Letter

Write a snow day letter to one of your friends or family members telling them all about your snow day. This can be real or imagined. Share what you have been doing and how you feel about the snow.

Try to include some adverbs and conjunctions to add detail about time, place or cause.

3. Create a Snow Themed Comic Strip

Draw a comic strip about a snow day adventure. Use speech bubbles, thought bubbles and narration to tell the story in words and pictures.

Challenge:

Try using inverted commas to write some dialogue between two characters.
